These few verses of today's Gospel, help us to understand better the story of the Passion and lead us almost into an intimate relationship with Jesus, in a closed place, set apart, where He is alone, facing Pilate: the Praetorium. He is questioned, He answers, in turn asks, continues to reveal His mystery of salvation and to invite people to come to Him. It is here that Jesus shows that He is king and shepherd; He is bound and crowned while under sentence of death. Here He leads us to the green pastures of His words of truth. This passage is part of a larger section, vv. 28–40, which tells us about the trial of Jesus before the governor. After a whole night of interrogation, beatings, jeers and betrayals, Jesus is handed over to the Roman authorities and is condemned to death. But it is in this very death that He reveals Himself as Lord, the One who came to give His life, the just One for us unjust, the innocent One for us sinners.
